

ORCHID GLADE

at Boulge Road, Hasketon, Woodbridge

Set your satnav to IP13 6JS
or (preferably) 52.1175°N 1.2894°E

Travelling north on the A12, shortly after the Sutton Hoo/Melton roundabout at Woodbridge, just beyond Saddlemakers Lane, take the first left, signposted to Bredfield.

From the north, after the end of the Wickham Market by-pass A12 dual carriageway, take the second right signposted to Bredfield.

In Bredfield village centre, keep left by the wrought-iron signpost, then bear immediately left again towards Hasketon (so not to Debach). After 800m, at the junction keep left, then pass Rose Cottage (on your left) and a footpath sign (pointing to the right). The lane straightens, with woodland on your right and arable fields on your left. Immediately beyond a slight curve right, see the entrance to Orchid Glade also on your right, opposite a field-entrance — if you reach the signpost for "Woodbridge 2", you have gone 120 metres too far. Drive in and park in the surfaced area to your right.

In general, our Open Days at Orchid Glade fall around mid-June, when it really lives up to its name, and early August, when the butterflies are at their most numerous — but watch
